# Wakulla County Christian Coalition, Inc. Arthur L. Andrews Scholarship - 2025

**Objective:** To provide assistance to eligible students who attend school in Wakulla County in need of financial assistance to further their education; those who have achieved academically as well as those who have demonstrated potential for successful academic achievement.

# Scholarship aid is for the current year graduating high school seniors to pursue a degree to become gainfully employed.

#### Two five-hundred-dollar (\$500) scholarships will be awarded to two qualified applicants.

## Guidelines

- 1. To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must be a high school senior in Wakulla County or a GED recipient (age 21 or younger). They must be in good standing—morally, socially, and academically—within their school and community and demonstrate a financial need for assistance in pursuing higher education.
- 2. Applicants must have completed a minimum of 10 hours of community service.
- 3. Each applicant must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0 at the end of the most recent grading period. GPA will be verified through an official school transcript.

All applications must be submitted electronically via email. The completed application packet **must be emailed by Saturday, April 5th** and include the following:

- a. Completed Application Form
  - The application must be completed electronically and signed digitally.
  - Handwritten applications will not be considered.
- b. List of School or Community Extra Curricular Activities (Clubs, Associations, Sports, etc)
  - The information should be current **through March** of the application year.
- c. Proof of Community Service Hours
  - Documentation verifying completion of at least 10 community service hours must be attached.
  - The verification must be signed by the individual supervising the service.
- d. Two Letters of Recommendation
  - One letter **from school personnel** (e.g., principal, teacher, advisor, or coach).
  - One letter **from an adult affiliated with a community organization or church** where the applicant is a member.
  - Letters should be addressed to the Arthur L. Andrews Scholarship Committee.
- e. 500-Word Essay
  - Formatting Requirements:
    - Typed, double-spaced
    - 12-point Times New Roman font
    - 1" margins on the sides and bottom

- 1.5" top margin
- Essay Topic: "Impacting Community in the Spirit of Service"
  - In honor of Arthur Lee Andrews, a distinguished military veteran and the only individual from Wakulla County killed in action during the Vietnam War, reflect on a community service project or initiative you have been involved in.
  - Describe how you identified the need, the steps you took to address it, and the impact of your actions.
  - Conclude by discussing how your efforts align with the values exemplified by Arthur Lee Andrews.
- f. Official Transcript
  - An official school transcript must be **emailed directly by the school administrator** to **Glenda Washington at** <u>gwash1205@gmail.com</u>.
- g. Verification of College or Vocational School Enrollment
  - A copy of the **college or vocational school acceptance letter** must be included in the application packet.

Application Review & Award Process

- The **Scholarship Committee will review all applications** and select recipients based on eligibility criteria.
- Once the selection process is complete, the scholarship will be awarded to the chosen individuals.
- Scholarship funds will be **mailed to the awardee or presented at the school awards** ceremony.
